your garden looking healthy this year!**

Although every year is a little different, this year has been especially difficult.

We have had drought-like conditions and the very hot humid days started in May this year. Those conditions make caring for your garden crucial this fall!

### Autumn tips to maintain your trees, shrubs and perennials

1. **THE FINAL WATERING** - During Early November, saturate all your plants before you turn off your outdoor water tap. This is especially important for evergreens, broad-leaf evergreens and anything planted within the last year or two.
2. **THE MIRACLE OF MULCH** - Mulch helps to maintain moisture in the soil. It also insulates plants, protecting them from the harmful effects of the freeze-thaw cycle that we experience in Windsor-Essex during March.
3. **SPRAY WILTPROOF** on your boxwoods and other broad-leaf evergreens to minimize the damage from the drying winter wind.
